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Setting the Standard for B&W's Business Conduct – In the United States

- Sarbanes-Oxley Act of 2002
 - > All U.S. publicly-traded companies must comply
 - ► Internal controls for managing risk
- Dodd-Frank Act
 - ➤ Whistleblower provision recovery up to 30% of penalties
 - ➤ No requirement to report internally
- Department of Justice U.S. Federal Sentencing Guidelines
 - Mandates robust ethics and legal compliance program
- ➤ U.S. Government Contractor Requirement
 - FAR 52.203-13

Setting the Standard for B&W's Business Conduct - Internationally

- Foreign Corrupt Practices Act (FCPA)
 - > Applies to JVs and Wholly Foreign Owned Entities (WFOE)
 - > Allows facilitation payments
- ➤ U.K. Bribery Act
 - ➤ No facilitation payments
 - ► Personal liability for UK Citizens
- > OECD Anti-Bribery Convention
- ➤ Anti-corruption laws of the countries in which we do business (ex. India, China)

Strategically Addressing the Issues

- Creation of Chief Compliance Officer role on Executive Staff, reporting directly to CEO and Board of Directors
- Compliance Managers embedded in Operating Groups
- Quarterly Business Review meetings with Operations Team and rest of Executive Staff
- Participation in annual Strategic Planning Sessions
- Performance Appraisals for all upper management tied to E&C practices
- Educate, Educate, Educate (A lot of training)
- > Annual Compliance Certifications
- Annual expense reporting
- Policies (Gifts & Entertainment, Sales Reps, Export Control)

Strategically Addressing the Issues

- Robust vetting of potential partners, suppliers, third parties
- Partnerships terms and conditions in the operating agreement address ethics and compliance
 - > Termination for evidence of violation of laws
 - ➤ Requirement for Ethics & Compliance program
 - ➤ Regular Training
 - ➤ Independent call line for reporting issues
 - Designation of responsible persons for Ethics & Compliance
 - ➤ Regular reporting to B&W Chief Compliance Officer
- > JVs require seat on the Board of Directors
- > Audits
